DESIGN 1017, "DOWNEY TYPE". Typical ship ABRON. 7500 tons dwt., standard dimensions 387 x 52 x 27. Triple expansion engines, oil fuel. All built by DOWNEY SHIPBUILDING Co., Staten Island, who had contracts for EFC hulls 216- 255, i.e. 10 ships. However the yard completed another one after finishing the EFC contract so TOTAL OUTPUT is 11.
